Stewart and on the production of satisfactory documentary proof of occurring with provisions of the Act of the General Assembly concerning said ward and guardianship bonds and was agreed by Council. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that the petitioners have leave and authority to demand, receive, sue for and recover any money or other personal property due and belonging to his said wards which may be in the hands of any person within the jurisdiction of this Court and remove the same from the State of Virginia to the County of D. Coto in the State of Mississippi where the said petitioners and his wards reside.

On consideration whereof the Court confirming said report to which no exception has been filed and on reading Statement of H. de la Roche, Esq. and decree that Amicus child of Charles, Phadon, Sarah, Charles and Maudslott children of Daniel, Euphemia & John children of Stuart, W. Henry, Lucy, Priscilla & Matilda children of Dechenard, Goodman, Susan, children of Sophus, Roland child of Charles, and Rosanna, Edwin Russell and Baker children of Dinwiddie as entitled to their freedom under the will of John Williamson and that Edwards Butts, Esq. of John Williamson Esq. be delivered to the several persons herein named and declared to be free a copy of the register of their freedom. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that Edwards Butts Esq. of John Williamson pay to Summell, Wither, Lewis, D. K. Addison, Jos. Anthony, Deke, Langell, Martha, Judith, Charlotte, Mariah, Stuart, Sophus, Am. Henry, Eliza, Dechenard, Caroline, Alabama, Dinah, Margaret, Obadiah, John, Colling, Mary, Amicus, Charles, Sarah, Charles, Maudslott, Euphemia, John, M. Henry, Lucy, Priscilla, Matilda, Goodman, Susan, Roland, Rosanna, Edwin Russell and Baker, negroes declared to be free under the will of John Williamson, each the sum of fifty five dollars and twelve cents, with interest thereon from November 1st 1855 till paid, and the said Butts will pay to the mothers of the infants respectively the amounts herein decreed to be paid to their infant children. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that Edwards Butts out of the hire of the present year pay the costs of this suit & all the expenses of obtaining registers of freedom for the herein named slaves above mentioned, and other expenses incurred and that third and the balance pay due equally to the persons herein before named and report to the Court.
