On consideration whereof the Court confirming said report to which an exception has been filed and on reading Statute H. held as judge, order and decree that Amiciana child of Charles Braden, Sarah, Charles and Mandak children of Daniel, Euphemia & John children of Stewart, W. Henry, Lucy, Priscilla & Matilda children of Deckerwood, Goodman, Susan, children of Sophien, Ralant child of Carlton, and Susanna, Edwin, Russell and Baker children of Dinwood as entitled to their freedom under the will of John H. Williamson and that Edward D. Ruttle, Com. of John Williamson does, subscribe to the several persons herein named and declared to be free a copy of the register of their freedom. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that Edward D. Ruttle Com. of John Williamson pay to Samuel, William, Lewis, D. K. Addison, Jos. Anthony, John, Benjamin, Martha, Judith, Charlotte, Francis, Stewart, Sophien, Ann, Nancy, Eliza, Deckerwood, Caroline, Alabama, Dinah, Margaret, Obadiah, James, Colling, Mary, Amiciana, Euphemia, Sarah, Charles, Mandak, Euphemia, John, W. Henry, Lucy, Priscilla, Matilda, Goodman, Susan, Ralant, Susanna, Edwin, Russell and Baker negroes declared to be free under the will of John Williamson, each the sum of fifty five dollars and twelve cents, with interest thereon from November 1<sup>st</sup> 1855 till paid, and the said Ruttle will pay to the mother of the infants res. per centum the amount herein decreed to be paid to their infant children. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that Edward D. Ruttle out of the hire of the present year pay the costs of this suit of all the expenses of obtaining Registers affidavit for the manumitted slaves above mentioned, and other expenses incurred a- bout them and the balance pay due equally to the persons herein before named and report to the Court.
