Smith as guardian of Edwin Harrison, and an account of the transactions of Edwin Harrison as guardian of M<sup>c</sup> Harrison, and an account of the transactions of James Cobb as guardian of Harrison Cobb and report the same to Court with any matters especially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required so to state by any of the parties.

Grader shall pay the said sums above mentioned the said Commissioner Smith convey to him the said tract of land with a special warranty and that the said Henry G. Grader and Anna Johansson pay and equal proportions the costs of this suit.
