the guardianship at law of Albert Bryant one of the said bonds for
£103. 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ s and also the bond for £647. 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ s and that the said John M.
Butler who is hereby appointed special Commissioner for that purpose
execute a deed with special warranty conveying the said land in the bill men-
tioned to the said Isipe Little so soon as the said bonds shall be paid off
respect to him; and that the plaintiff and Defendants pay in equal
proportion the costs incurred in this suit since the May term 1855,-
But this decree as to the delivery of the bonds hereby deems to the
said guardians shall be suspended until the said guardians respon-
sibly execute bonds with sufficient security in the Clerk's Office
of this Court, the said guardians at law of Albert Bryant in the
sum of One Thousand Dollars and the said guardians for Victoria
Bryant & Richard S. Drew at the sum of Three hundred dollars
each continuing to invest the money so saved by the said bonds
in the purchase of State Stock bearing interest at six per
cent or loaning out the same taking good personal or real
security.

This cause came on this day to be again heard upon the paper formerly
read and upon the report of L. C. P. Cooper special Commissioner
made herein pursuant to the decree of the 3^d day of May 1855
to which no protest or exceptions have been filed and was argued by
Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth confirm and approve and
doth adjudge, order and decree that the said L. C. P. Cooper,
return as of neare proceed to collect the two bonds of the
purchase by A. D. Drew which are retained with his said
report at their maturity and to invest under the same and make
to the said Francis a good and sufficient discharge of conveyance
for the land in the bill and proceeding mentioned with special
warranty; And the said Commissioner is directed to pay over
the proceeds of the said two bonds to the Complainant Lucy S.
Drew to be held by her subject to the provisions of the will
of Albert Drew deceased, upon the execution by the said Lucy
S. Drew of a bond with sufficient security in the penalty of £1400.
