This cause came on this day to be again heard upon the papers formerly
 read and upon the report of A. L. P. Comper Special Commissioner
 made herein pursuant to the decree of the 3rd day of May 1855
 to which on part no exceptions have been filed and was argued by
 Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth confirm and is precluded
 not to deny, order and decree that the said A. L. P. Comper,
 do as aforesaid proceed to collect the two bonds of the
 purchasers A. L. P. Francis which are returned with his said
 report at their maturity and to surrender the same and make
 to the said Francis a good and sufficient deed of conveyance
 for the land in the bill and proceedings mentioned with Special
 warranty; and that the said Commissioner is directed to pay over
 the proceeds of the said two bonds to the Complainant Lucy S.
 Dins to be held by her subject to the provisions of the will
 of Anst Dins deceased upon the execution by the said Lucy
 S. Dins of a bond with sufficient security in the penalty of \$2400.
 conditioned to deliver the said proceeds forthwith at her death;
 the said bond to be returned and filed with the papers in this
 cause. But if the said Lucy S. Dins shall refuse to give such
 bond or fail to do so for six months after the making of this decree
 then the said A. L. P. Comper is directed to invest the said proceeds
 in his own name as Commissioner for the benefit of the purchaser in
