2nd An account of the real and personal estate showing the value of each allotted to Mary Harris as her dower and to whom the said dower property is devised and bequeathed by the will of the said Howell Harris after the death in marriage of the said Mary Harris.

3rd An account of the real estate and slaves of which the said Howell Harris died seized showing the value of each, and to whom the said property was devised and bequeathed after the death in marriage of the said Mary Harris, and the value of the share of each devisee or legatee.

4th An account of the perishable property directed to be sold by the 8th clause of the will of the said Howell Harris showing the aggregate value thereof and the value thereof after the payment of debts and report the same to Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required so to state by any of the parties.
