The Plaintiff in these two causes having process against the defendants  
ants Ethrie & wife and Holmead & wife in the manner presented by law and  
they still failing to appear and answer the said cause came on the day  
by consent of parties to be heard together the first of term upon the bill  
of the complainants regularly taken for confess at the rules as to the  
defendants J. J. Trisby, the answers of Charles Martine and Elliott L.  
Stay general replication to the said answers and exhibits filed. And the  
second of the said causes upon the bill of the complainants regularly  
taken for confess at the rules as to the defendants Carl Bowes,  
Lee W. Smith and Mary his wife and John J. Trisby. The answers  
of the defendants E. L. Stay and Chas Martine and general replication  
to the said answers and exhibits filed and were argued by Counsel. On  
consideration whereof and by little consent of parties the Court doth  
adjudge and decree that C. W. Maflinburg, W. B. Shands and R.  
St. Baker Jr. who are appointed Commissioners for the purpose, any one  
or more of whom may act present after giving fifteen days notice of the  
time and place of sale in one or more newspapers published in Newfolt City  
and by notices posted in the neighborhood of the premises to sell at public  
auction to the highest bidder the Steam Saw Mill and fixtures and such other  
property which has been attached in these causes as has not been  
already sold upon the following terms first, one third in cash and  
the balance upon a credit of 3 & 6 months taking from the purchaser  
two bonds in equal amounts with sufficient security payable to the  
said Commissioners and it is further ordered that the defendant E. L. Stay  
trustee pay to the said Commissioners the sum of \$308.20 being the  
balance in his hands as appears by his answer, and that Saml. Hall  
Sheriff of Southampton County pay over to the said Commissioners the  
sum of \$454.77 being the net proceeds of sale of part of the attach-
