This day this case was again heard at the papers formerly read together
 with the report of William J. Magitt Special Commissioner and the certificate
 of deposit returned therewith, and the report of Henry S. Howard one of the
 Commissioners of this Court showing the value of the said Mary A. Brown's
 interest in one third of the real estate in the proceedings mentioned to which
 said reports there being no exceptions filed, the same are confirmed by
 the Court; On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order
 and decree that W^m J. Magitt the Special Commissioner proceed to
 collect the bond in the proceedings mentioned and which will fall due on
 the first day of January A.D. 1857, or so soon as the same shall fall due
 and which for that purpose may be delivered to him by the Clerk
 pay all further legal expenses and charges incurred in obtaining
 the decree pronounced in this case reserving nothing further to himself
 the said Commission as Commissions for collecting the same and that he
 deposit the residue in the Norfolk Savings Institution in the City of Norfolk
 take a receipt or certificate for the same and file the said certificate
 with the papers in this Cause together with the report to be made
 by him to this Court. But the said W^m J. Magitt is not to pro-
 ceed to the discharge of the duties enjoined by this decree until he
 shall have executed in the Clerk's Office of this Court a bond
 payable to the Commonwealth with sufficient personal security in
 the penalty of six thousand dollars conditional for the faithful per-
 formance of the said duties according to Law.
 And the said Special Commission is further ordered as to the payment
 the amount of the said bond to him by the purchasers to execute to
 them a good and sufficient deed with Special warranty conveying the
 said real estate in the proceedings mentioned and to report to this Court
 in order to a final decree.
