This day this cause came on to be argued and the papers filed and read the report of William J. Schell Commissioner in D. in pursuance of a Decree made in this cause on November Term 1855 to which I put no questions have been filed and the Court confirming the same do hereby advise and decree that the Clerk of this Court deliver to Mr. J. Schell the bond of George W. Schell and James C. Schell executed to the said Schell Commissioner for the amt of \$1771 on bearing date the 21st day of January 1856 and due twelve months after date that the said Schell collect the same when due and pay one half to Mr. J. Schell and one fifth of the balance to James C. Schell one fifth to George W. Schell and one fifth to Mr. J. Schell guardian to William N. Schell and the remaining two fifths to the legally qualified guardian of Nicholas and Virginia Schell when one shall be appointed and file in this cause the proper evidence of his appointment and qualification and the Court doth further advise and decree that the said Clerk also deliver to the said William J. Schell the two bonds of Jas. M. Schell and L. D. Beahm executed to the said Schell Commissioner each for the sum of \$1205.80/100 and bearing date the 21st day of January 1856, one of which bonds is due the 21st day of January 1857 and the other on the 21st day of January 1858; that the said Schell collect the same when due or when the several obligors may choose to pay them and after paying the expenses of this decree pay in the first place to Mr. J. Schell the sum of \$500. and that he pay one fifth of the balance to James C. Schell, one fifth to George W. Schell and one fifth to Mr. J. Schell guardian to William N. Schell and the remaining two fifths to the legally qualified guardian of Nicholas and Virginia Schell when one shall be appointed and file in this cause the proper evidence of his appointment and qualification. That in the payment of the said bond of \$1771 by the said George W. Schell that the said Mr. J. Schell shall execute a deed to the said George W. Schell with open covenants, conditions and law to preserve in him and his heirs and assigns an acre and a half of land by the said James C. Schell that the said William J. Schell shall execute to the said James C. Schell a deed with special warranty for the tract of land in the proceedings mentioned of which Nicholas M. Schell did charge and possess being near the Town of Jerusalem and containing about five hundred acres. But the said Clerk shall not deliver to the said Mr. J. Schell the said bonds before mentioned until he shall execute bond with sufficient security in the Clerk's office of this Court and before the said Clerk in the penalty of \$1000.00 payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia conditioned for the faithful performance of his duty under this decree. And this decree shall be suspended as to the said Schell guardian to William N. Schell and the guardian of Nicholas and Virginia Schell until each shall execute bond payable
