On consideration whereof the Court confirming said report doth a foredo, order and decree that William J. Goodenough who is appointed Commissioner receive from the Clerk's Office the bond for the proceeds of the sale of the real estate, awarded by H. M. Everett and B. C. Everett in the sum of \$550. on the 15th day of June 1857, which was returned with his report and collect the same, and out of the proceeds thereof, after paying of the costs of sale and of this suit, pay to John R. Davis Esq. of Williams & Watkins the sum of \$115.90 with interest thereon from the 1st September 1855 to Catho. C. Vick and his wife Sarah C. Vick the sum of \$86.75 with interest thereon from the 15th June 1857, and to the following named persons the following amounts with interest on each from the said last named day to wit: To B. C.
