This day this cause came on to be again heard on the papers formerly read, on the report of Commr James Howard made pursuant to the order of the May Term 1857 to which report there is no exception, and on statement made in Court, and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court confirming the said report and adopting the statement, doth adjudge, order and decree that Erwin Griffen admr of William A Griffen & Eugene J Griffen shall pay the following amounts to wit: to Robert M Dales \$5.85<sup>00</sup>, to William Atkinson \$7.55, to Joseph W Williams \$9.25<sup>00</sup> and \$28.99<sup>00</sup> to Robert G Edwards \$27.23<sup>00</sup>, to Black Brick Church \$5.77<sup>00</sup>, to W<sup>m</sup> Ball \$7.98, to James Adams \$4.94<sup>00</sup>, to Ben Brown \$10.16, to Erwin Griffen \$12.16, to Erwin Duck \$13.10<sup>00</sup>, to Robert M Dales \$31.29, to Darden & Savage \$1.61, to R. D. Darden \$0.67, to Matthew Harris \$23.91, to Mordecai Bradshaw \$53.92, \$28.16 and \$57.91<sup>00</sup> and to Elizabeth Proctor \$43.95, and unless the defendant Eugene J Griffen or some one for him before the expiration of six months shall pay the following sums to wit: to Robert M Dales \$6.53<sup>00</sup>, to W<sup>m</sup> Atkinson \$5.26, to Joseph W Williams \$11.17, \$24.70<sup>00</sup>, to Robert G Edwards \$30.29<sup>00</sup>, to Black Brick Church \$6.72<sup>00</sup>, to W<sup>m</sup> Ball \$9.22, to James Adams \$5.57<sup>00</sup>, to Ben Brown \$14.50, to Erwin Griffen \$15.50, to Erwin Duck \$12.69<sup>00</sup>, to Robert M Dales \$35.26, to Darden & Savage \$2.81, to R. D. Darden \$0.76, to Matthew Harris \$49.16, to Mordecai Bradshaw \$58.24, \$32.59 and \$19.54<sup>00</sup> and to Elizabeth Proctor \$49.26, with interest on each from this date, then Erwin Griffen who is hereby appointed a special Commissioner for that purpose shall after having given twenty days notice by advertisement of the Court-house and at two or more public places, sell the land in the lots mentioned, whereof the said William A Griffen died, seized and possessed to the highest bidder at public auction, and after receiving so much in cash as may be required to pay the expenses of such sale and the costs of this suit, that for the balance of the proceeds thereof he take bond with good security payable in twelve months and return the same with his report to Court. But this decree shall be of no effect until the said Erwin Griffen shall have entered into bond in the Clerk's Office of this Court payable to the Commissioners of Virginia in the penalty of \$1500 with good security conditioned faithfully to discharge his duties as such Commissioner.
