Edwards aforesaid to defend them in this suit general replication there to or the exhibits of was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth judge and command, that Robt H. Whelby & John R. Chamberlain ^{or either of them} commissioners for such purpose, persons to sell at public auction to the highest bidder the real estate including the mill property in the proceedings mentioned whereof the lot Shadwell Blythe described as being a tract of six rods by eighteen months in equal payments with interest from day of sale taking bond with sufficient security from the purchaser retaining the title until the first 1800 of next and report to Court and return the said bonds with the report. And the Court doth further order that a Commissioner of this Court take and account of the several parties entitled to the fund and the amount due them, and that he account what sum in fee simple should be paid to Nancy Bennett formerly Nancy Blythe in view of her life interest in the same. And that he advise the taking of such accounts in case it may appear published in the State or in the State of Virginia in kind of personal notice to the parties. But the same is to be suspended until R. H. Whelby & John R. Chamberlain ^{or either of them} file a copy of \$5000 00 before the Clerk of this Court payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia conditioned for the faithful performance of this duty.
