This cause came on this day to be again heard upon the papers formerly read and
upon the report of Commissioners. Howard taken and estimated having pursuant
to the decree of the 1st Day of May 1855, to which report no exceptions
have been filed and was agreed by Plaintiff, On consideration whereof
the Court doth confirm the said report and both adjudge and direct
that W^m R. Edwards Special Commissioner proceed to collect the
sums returned with his report of Sales filed herein on the 9th Day
of January 1855 as they respectively fall due (for which purpose) the
Clerk of this Court is directed to surrender the same to him and that he
collect and receive from Nelson B. Gardner the balance due from him as
a trustee of Jas. R. Williams deceased as appears by a memorandum
upon the report of Comr. Howard aforesaid, and pay out of the funds
so collected (as received by him) the costs of this cause, and the several debts
