This cause comes on this day to be again heard upon the papers formerly read, upon the report of Comr. Howard made pursuant to the decree of the day of November 1857, to which no exceptions have been filed and upon the report of L. R. Edwards filed to the report of Commissioner Howard taken and returned herein on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of October 1857 and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof, the Court doth confirm the said first named report and sustaining the said exception doth remand the said last mentioned report to the said Commissioner to be corrected and reformed as may be right and proper and the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree, that L. R. Edwards alias of G. A. W. Newson deceased remaining in his hands the sum of five hundred dollars after balance of £5119. 09 due by him to the estate of his intitute as shown by Commissioner Howard's report of the 6<sup>th</sup> April 1855, his duty is to pay out the residue thereof ten to the sum of £1619. 09 per cent among the several creditors of his said G. A. W. Newson deceased whose claims are reported by Comr. Howard in his report of the 6<sup>th</sup> October 1857, and that he make a report of his said payment setting therewith the receipt of the several parties. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree, that a Commissioner of this Court state the following accounts.

No: 1 A further account of the transactions of L. R. Edwards, alias of G. A. W. Newson.

2. An account showing the balances due to each of the creditors of the said G. A. W. Newson deceased after the distribution among them of his personal effects.

Which amounts the said Commissioner is directed to state, calling on the Court report together with any matter especially stated & found to himself or which may be required by either party etc
