This cause came on this day to be again heard upon the papers formerly read, upon the report of Comm. Howard made pursuant to the decree of the 1st day of November 1857, to which no exceptions have been filed and upon the receipt of L. R. Edwards filed to the report of Commissioner Howard formal and returned herein on the 11th day of October 1857 and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof, the Court doth confirm the said first named report and sustaining the said exceptions doth recommend the said said Commissioner's report to the said Commissioner to be corrected and returned as may be right and proper and the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that L. R. Edwards admr of G. A. M. Mowson do receive returning in his hands the sum of five hundred dollars of the balance of \$519.09 due by him to the estate of his intestate as shown by Commissioner Howard's report of the 30th April 1855, his books and pay out the residue thereof to wit, the sum of \$1619.09 pro rata among the general creditors of the said G. A. M. Mowson do receive whose claims are reported by Comm. Howard in his report of the 6th October 1857, and that he make an report of his said payments falling thereunto the receipt of the several parties. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that a Commissioner of this Court state the following accounts.

viz: 1. A further account of the transactions of L. R. Edwards, as admr of G. A. M. Mowson.

2. An account showing the balances due to each of the creditors of the said G. A. M. Mowson deceased after the distribution among them of the funds aforesaid.

Which accounts the said Commissioner is directed to state, settle and to the Court report together with any matter specially stated or brought forward by himself or which may be required by either party &c as stated.
