This day this cause came on again to be heard upon the papers formerly read and the report of Commissioner Shands made pursuant to a decree entered at the November Term 1858 of this Court and to which no exceptions have been filed and the Court confirming the same doth further adjudge, order and decree that the defendant Mr. B.
