This cause came on this day to be heard with papers formerly read and the report of Richard L. Bryant, the Commissioner appointed by the Deems. Judge of Dorcas in the said day of May A.D. 1860, to which report there is no exception and was argued by counsel for the plaintiff. On consideration whereof the Court approving and confirming said report, doth adjudge, order and decree that the said Richard L. Bryant shall receive and collect the said interest due his said report as soon as it shall fall due (which said bond was returned to the said Commissioner by Benjamin J. Bryant in the sum of nine hundred and ninety dollars for the purchase of the real estate in the proceedings under said) and shall receive therefor the said Benjamin J. Bryant a deed with special warranty, granting and conveying to him the said real estate in the said proceedings under said.

It is further ordered that when the said Commissioner shall have received payment of the said bond of \$990.00 cents, the same shall be considered in his hands as guardian for the said Dorcas Ann Bawett Calcutta St. Bawett v John D. Bawett, and he shall forthwith leave it out to him in good and sufficient personal or real security as by instrument in Virginia State that do & his Decree, and file among the papers of this cause a certificate of actual evidence of such bond of instrument. And the said Commissioner is directed to report his proceedings under this Deems to Court.

And this Deems is to be suspended until the said Richard L. Bryant guardian of the said Dorcas Ann Bawett, Calcutta St. Bawett and John D. Bawett shall so be into bond with sufficient security with penalty of \$2000.00 in the County Office of this Court conditioned well and faithfully to execute for the amount of money received by him under this Deems as such guardian aforesaid.
