Stephenson for £110.95 filed in this cause, which said bond the Clerk of this Court is directed to hand and upon payment to him of said bond to execute to the said infant heir of the said Wm R. Stephenson subject to the several rights of his widow a deed with special warranty for said land. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that out of the money so collected he pay first the expenses of this cause, and the balance the Commissioner is directed to distribute for and among the creditors of Miles Scarborough d^r bankrupt of whose debts is filed in this cause, and the Commissioner is directed to report his proceedings made this day to Court.
