It being suggested to the Court that Wm R. Stephenson since he became the purchaser of the land in the proceedings mentioned under a decree hereof entered in this court, has defrauded this life having first executed his bond with sufficient security for the purchase money leaving a widow named Anne and an infant child named Andrew his heirs at law by consent of justice it is ordered that this suit be revived against the said widow and infant child, whereupon this cause coming on again to be heard on the papers formerly read and on the report of Commissioner Postlor who was appointed to settle the real estate in the proceedings mentioned, said report made in pursuance of a decretal order entered in this cause at the May Term of this Court 1860 and was argued by Council. On consideration whereof the Court approving and confirming said report doth adjudge, order and decree that Wm R. Postlor who is appointed a special Commissioner for that purpose be directed to collect the bond against the said Wm R. Stephenson for \$1100.95 filed in this cause, which said bond the Clerk of this Court is directed to hand to hand and upon frequent to him of said bond to be used to the said infant heirs of the said Wm R. Stephenson subject to the dower right of his widow, a deed with special warranty for said land. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that out of the money so collected he pay first the expenses of this decree, and the balance the Commissioner is directed to distribute pro rata amongst the creditors of Abigail Scarborough dec^d whose account of whose debts is filed in this cause, and the Commissioner is directed to report his proceedings under this decree to Court.
