This Cause came on the day to be spent heard on the papers formerly made & on the reports of Wm. H. Butler and of James Holmes & Matilda Butler Counsel for the defendants the decree of May Term 1860, to which reports there is no exception and was argued by counsel, the cause was then referred to the Court with advice thereon and leave that James Holmes & Matilda & Butler receive a full Clerk of this Court and that the said Clerk deliver to them the Bond of Franklin Vick Lien to the Phenomenon and G. W. Vick for \$1419.89, filed with the cause, and that they proceed to collect the same and out of the proceeds thereof pay any costs that may remain unpaid & that they pay to Milton D. Butler & Mary P. his wife the sum of \$500 -- with interest thereon from the 24th day of October 1860 till paid in full of the Bond of said Mary P. late Mary P. Holmes in the real estate sold under the proceedings in this cause and the balance pay to the said Milton D. Butler guardian of Wm. H. Holmes and the said James Holmes and Milton D. Butler are directed to execute a Bond for the net estate refused to emit Franklin Vick the purchaser at the usual form with special warranty and make it up to Court.

But before any payment under this decree shall be made to the said Milton D. Butler as guardian of Wm. H. Holmes he the said Butler shall appear before the Clerk of this Court in his office a Bond payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the penalty of \$1500. conditioned as other guardian bonds are conditioned.

And that the bond be adjourned till to morrow morning for trial.
