This day the cause came on in E. C. heard in the last of the Complaint and taken for confessed as to the defendant upon which process has been duly served and she still failing to answer the said bill, an ex parte and was argued by Counsel. At the consideration whereof the Court hath adjudged and decreed that Wm. M. Dutton who is hereby appointed a special Commissioner for that purpose unless the Defendant Amos D. Barrett come in for her pay to the Complainant the amount of two executions to wit; one for the sum of \$20.00 with interest from 2^d day of January 1860 another for the sum of \$35.89 with interest from 2^d day of January 1860 and the cost of this suit in the proceedings mentioned within sixty days from the date hereof, shall after having given at least twenty days notice of time and place of sale proceed to sell at public auction for cash the interest in remainder belonging to Amos D. Barrett in the three young negro children in possession of Sarah Barrett widow of Ringe Barrett being her dower interest and out of proceeds of said sale pay first the costs of this suit and then pay A. Williams the amount of the two executions in the proceedings mentioned & the costs of said executions and the balance if any pay to Amos D. Barrett. But the execution of this decree is to be suspended until the Commissioner shall have given bond on the Clerk's office of this Court with good and sufficient security payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the penalty of \$500 or conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust herein assigned him.

All matters and causes pending in this Court and not otherwise disposed of are severally continued until the next term.

And that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
