On consideration whereof the Court with advice, order and decree, that one of the commissioners of this Court take the following accounts to wit: an account of the transactions of Walter Broadbent as administrator of Jovin Griffon dec^d, an account of the outstanding debts against the estate of Jovin Griffon, an account of the real and personal value of the real estate of which Jovin Griffon dec^d possessed, an account of the fee simple value of Alford Griffon's share interest in said real estate, and an account of the value of the share of which the said Griffon dec^d possessed and possessed and report the same to Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which may be required to be stated by any other parties.

This day this cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read and the report of Commissioner Broadbent made pursuant to a decree of this Court entered at the November Term 1859 to which no exceptions have been filed, and was argued by counsel. On the hearing whereof the Court confirming the said report with advice, order and decree, that Henry J Howard the trustee pay out of the trust fund or his hands the costs of this suit up to this time and receiving enough to meet the other costs that may arise, pay to Richard W Blythe and the other creditors of the second class as ascertained by the schedule marked B in Commissioner Broadbent's report *pro rata*, the sum of eleven hundred and twenty dollars eighty eight cents with interest thereon from the date, it being the balance due after paying the creditors of the first class, and file his receipts among the papers of this cause.
