

At a Court for the County of Southampton held at the Courtroom thereof on Friday the 7th day of November 1862

This day this cause came on again to be heard in the papers formerly read and the reports of Henry James Parker of Willis Broadshaw's administration as administrator of the estate of Edwin Griffin dec^d and an account of debts outstanding against the said estate also an account of the value of the real and personal estate of the said Edwin Griffin and was argued by counsel. On the hearing whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that the said accounts be recommended to a Commissioner of this Court with directions he restore an account of Willis Broadshaw's administration as administrator of Edwin Griffin dec^d and also to take a further account of debts outstanding against the said Edwin Griffin estate. And it appearing to the Court necessary from an examination of the said accounts, the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that Willis Broadshaw who is hereby appointed a special Commissioner for that purpose, shall after giving twenty days notice by public advertisement proceed to sell at public auction to the highest bidder for cash, all the slaves belonging to the estate of Edwin Griffin dec^d and report his proceedings to this Court. But the said Willis Broadshaw shall not proceed to act under this decree until he or some one for him shall have executed in the Clerk's Office of this Court a bond in the penalty of eight thousand dollars with sufficient security for due faithful performance of this decree. And the Court doth further decree that the said Willis Broadshaw pay the costs of this suit including a fee of fifty dollars each to Messrs. H. Shanks and to Messrs. H. Parker.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning ten o'clock.
