 solved and the said Margaret Scott forever divorced from her husband
 Levi Scott and all the right, title and interest of the said Levi Scott in
 or to the estate real or personal of the said Margaret Scott shall
 henceforth cease and determine and the court doth further adjudge,
 order and decree that the five infant children issue of the marriage
 between William Scott, William Scott, Levi and John Scott be awarded
 to the custody of the mother Margaret Scott who is to have the
 guardianship and entire control of them during their minority free
 from all influence or control of their father Levi Scott and that
 the plaintiff recover from the defendant her costs by her expended
 in the prosecution of this suit. And nothing further remaining
 to be done in this suit it is ordered that the same be removed
 from the docket, but leave is reserved to the parties to make
 application to the court for such further orders as are
 authorized by law.
