June 1866, this cause having by said Decree been transferred to this Court and was argued by Counsel. In consideration whereof, the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that John Goodie who is hereby appointed a Commissioner for that purpose, proceed to sell at the late residence of W. B. Wigham & Co. in said County after having given thirty days notice of the said sale by advertisement at the Court House door of said County and various other public places in said County and also twice a week for three weeks in one or more newspapers published in Norfolk City & in the City of Petersburg, the Lands referred to in said proceedings (and which are so commanded by the Commissioners) to whom the same was referred for partition to be sold and sold. The Home tract north of the Public Road containing by estimation 537 acres more or less.

2^d The Johnson tract of Land north of the Public Road lying to Blackwater, containing 238 acres.

3^d The Brown tract lying south of the Public Road containing 350 acres.

4th The Burt tract containing 916 1/2 acres.

5th The Aspermoss tract containing 2097 acres. That in making such sales, the said Commissioner is authorized to sell the said Lands in such parcels as may be best for all parties and shall sell on the following terms to-wit: one fifth cash and the balance on one and two years credit with interest from date, the interest to be paid annually and the purchaser to give bond with good personal security and the title to said Lands to be retained till the further order of Court, and out of the cash sales to pay costs of said & expenses of sale & make report of same to the Court.

And it is further ordered that a Commissioner of this Court as soon as such sales shall have been made to ascertain the share of each party entitled, of the value of said Lands including that allotted to Bennett Wigham and W. B. Wigham and of that sold under this decree.

But no sale is to be made under this decree until the said John Goodie shall execute before the Clerk of this Court his said office, a bond in the penalty of \$20,000 payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia conditioned for the faithful discharge of the duties of said Commissioner under this Decree and under any other decree or order that may be made in this cause.
