This cause came on this day to be again heard upon the papers formally read and upon the report of John Gooden Commissioner made pursuant to the decree of November Term 1866, to which report there is no exception and was agreed by counsel. But before the said John Gooden Commissioner shall make any payment under this decree to any Guardian aforesaid the said Guardian shall execute before the Clerk of this Court in his official bonds for each of said wards in the penalty of five thousand dollars payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia conditioned for the faithful use and appropriation of the said fund as also any other moneys that they may receive from the proceeds of the sale of the real estate sold under proceedings in this cause.
