This Cause came on this day to be again heard & on the Report of
Commissioner Howard, Made pursuant to the decree of the 8th of
November 1856, to which report there is no exception and was argued
by Counsel. The Court in its deliberations on the Court doth Confront the said
Report, and doth assign, Order and decree, that George W. Dick,
(who is hereby appointed a Commissioner for that purpose,) proceed
to Sell before the Court House door of Southampton County, on some
Court day, in a Credit of Nine Months with Interest from date,
purchaser for a Sum Sufficient to pay the Costs of Suit including
an Attorney's fee of \$50. and expenses of Sale, which he will
receive in Cash, and pay to those entitled. The Lands referred to
in the proceedings, described as containing 128 1/2 per. acres, More or less,
and adjoining the Lands of John F. Myrick, the North Carolina
State line, and others, and of which the said James Mayett did
propose, that such Sale be Made in auction, and in such parcels
as the said Commissioner may deem proper, and if a part of said
Lands should be for enough to satisfy the demands against said
James Mayett then the Commissioner will only Sell that Much
and no More; That the said Commissioner will advertise such
Sale at the Court House door and at least six other public places
in the Neighborhoo of the premises, and in one or more
Newspapers, for at least twenty Days previous to such Sale, and
will Make report of said proceedings to Court and return the
Points of the purchase with his Report. But no Sale shall be
Made until this decree shall the expiration of the present stay
have, nor until the said George W. Dick as Commissioner agreed
shall execute before the Clerk of this Court in his official, a Bond
in the penalty of \$4000, payable to the Commissioners of
Virginia and conditioned to execute faithfully this decree and
any other decree that he may be required to execute pending
proceedings had in this cause.
