This day this Cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly filed, and on the report of Commissioner Harriod, made pursuant to the Order of this Court 1855. to which no exceptions have been filed, and on the Statute under which (Act 1853) and was argued by Counsel in Consideration whereof, the Court conforming such report, doth adjudge Order and decree that William W. Briggs out of the Land of \$250.00 in his hands, deliver from the same of the Bank in the proceedings mentioned, his authority to appropriate the sum of \$65.00 for the benefit of the two infant defendants James and Mrs. Norton, this amount being one fourth of the fund, and out of the balance, remaining in his hands, to wit, the sum of \$185.00 he do pay the Cost of this Suit, and the remainder of said amount, he pay to W. S. Berkeley Casarides of Samuel Denny, in full Satisfaction of the Claims of said Denny, against the Estate of Jesse Turner, reported by Commissioner Harriod, and the Court doth further adjudge, Order and Decree, that William W. Briggs be appointed a Commissioner and receiver of the Land, who is hereby directed to raise one hundred and twenty dollars, after the expiration of the present year, the said in the proceedings mentioned, of which Jesse Turner, said Leg't. and report his proceedings to Court, and being so raised, to the amount deposited to receive out of them, and keep the account, after the payment of the debt, such accounts respectively as will appearing their portions with the portions of the infant Defendants, James and Mrs. Norton.
