This day this Cause came on again to be heard on the papers forming a bill, and on the report of Commissioner Howard, made pursuant to the Order of this Court 1855. to which was excepted have been filed, and on the Statute under March 2 (1855) and was argued by Counsel in Consideration whereof, the Court confirming such report, doth adjudge Order with costs, that William W. Briggs out of the Land of \$250.00 in his hands, demand from the sale of the Land in the proceedings mentioned, be authorized to appropriate the sum of \$85.00 for the benefit of the two infant defendants James and Wm. Norton, this amount being one fourth of the fund, and out of the balance, remaining in his hands, to wit, the sum of \$165.00 he pay to W. S. Gookesay Casarator of Samuel Drury, in full Satisfaction of the claims of said Drury, against the Estate of Super Turner, assigned by Commissioner Howard, and the Court doth further adjudge, Order and Award, that William W. Briggs be appointed a Commissioner and receiver of the fund, who is hereby directed to raise and find good & good, after the expiration of the present year, the fund in the proceedings mentioned, of which Super Turner, said Leg. Ad., reports his proceedings to Court, and being received to the amount defendants to receive out of the fund thereof, after the payment of the debts, such proceeds respectively as will equitably their portions with the portions of the infant Defendants, James and Wm. Norton.
