Charles F. Wrightson, Margaret A. Wrightson, James B. Wrightson,
in his own right and as administrator of A. B. Wrightson, Esq. deceased, Defendants.
This day the Com. came on to be of our heard upon the papers formerly
read, and the report of Commissioners' held made in pursuance of the above
process in the cause at the November Term A. D. 1856, to which Report
there are no exceptions, and was argued by Counsel. Upon Consideration
whereof the Court doth Confirm the said report, and it appearing that the
said C. F. Wrightson, as guardian is entitled to his Ward the said
Fanny Wrightson and the said Margaret A. Wrightson in the sum
of Thirty three thousand, eight hundred dollars invested in Regis-
tered bonds of the State of Virginia, in the sum of Twenty six
Thousands four hundred dollars invested in Norfolk City bonds, in
the sum of Four thousand and fifty six dollars, amount of interest
on registered bonds, funded in new bonds of the State of Virginia,
together a sum of approximately, in the sum of Five thousand
six hundred and fifty dollars, interest on Norfolk City bonds,
funded in favor of the said City, and in the sum of Six thousand
six hundred and fifty Seven dollars and eighty three cents,
invested in individual bonds. The Court doth by consent of
parties, adjudge, Order and decree, that the said C. F. Wrightson,
Guardian as aforesaid, do pay to the Plaintiff one half of the
said sum of Thirty three thousand eight hundred dollars,
invested in registered bonds of the State of Virginia, one
half of the said sum of Twenty six thousand four hundred
dollars, invested in Norfolk City bonds, one half of the said
sum of Four thousand and fifty six dollars, amount of fund
interest on registered bonds of the State of Virginia, and one
half of the said sum of Five thousand six hundred and fifty
dollars, amount of funded interest on Norfolk City bonds and to
Court doth further adjudge, Order and decree that the said
C. F. Wrightson, guardian as aforesaid, do present to Court
as rapidly as possible the said sum of Six thousand six hundred
and fifty seven dollars and eighty three cents, invested in the bonds
of individuals, and pay one half of the same when ordered
to the Plaintiff after the Court doth further adjudge,
Order and decree, this day: Hobson, John Postlethwait, John P.
Boyle, J. B. Wrightson, and William Wrightson, who are
hereby appointed Commissioners for the purpose, any sum or
whole may act, do divide the Chattel Estate consisting of
Horses, Stock of Hogs, Cattle and farming implements belong-
ing to the farm known as the "Old place" in Smith and Co-
unty, into two parts of equal value, as nearly as practi-
cable, and allot one share to the Plaintiff and the other to
the Plaintiff and of the said defendant, Margaret A. Wrightson
and Charles F. Wrightson to Plaintiff.
