This day the Court came on to be again heard upon the papers formerly
read, and the report of Commissioner Cobb made in pursuance of the same
pursuant to the Court at the November Term A. D. 1855. to which Report
there are no exceptions, and was argued by Counsel. Upon consideration
whereof the Court doth approve the said report, and it appearing that the
said C. F. Bygones, as guardian is indebted to his wards the said
Penny Bygones and the said Margaret A. Bygones in the sum
of Thirty three thousand, eight hundred dollars invested in Regi-
sterd bonds of the State of Virginia, in the sum of Twenty Six
thousand seven hundred dollars invested in Norfolk City bonds, in
the sum of Four thousand and fifty six dollars, amount of interest
on registered bonds, found in new bonds of the State of Virginia,
bonds a certain set of apportion, in the sum of Five thousand
Six hundred and fifty dollars, interest on Norfolk City bonds,
found in new of the said City, and in the sum of Six thousand
six hundred and fifty seven dollars and eighty three Cents,
invested in individual bonds. The Court doth by consent of
parties, adjudged, Order and decree, That the said C. F. Bygones,
Guardian as aforesaid, do pay to the Plaintiff one half of the
said sum of Thirty three thousand eight hundred dollars,
invested in registered bonds of the State of Virginia, one
half of the said sum of Twenty six thousand seven hundred
dollars, invested in Norfolk City bonds, one half of the said
sum of Four thousand & fifty six dollars, amount of found
interest on registered bonds of the State of Virginia, and one
half of the said sum of Five thousand six hundred and fifty
dollars, amount of found interest on Norfolk City bonds And the
Court doth further adjudged, Order and decree That the said
C. F. Bygones, guardian as aforesaid, do procure to collect
as rapidly as possible the said sum of Six thousand seven hundred
and fifty seven dollars and eighty three Cents, invested in the bonds
of individuals, and pay one half of the same when collected
to the Plaintiff and the Court doth further adjudged,
Order and decree, That Peter J. Holmes, John Crockett, John B.
Bygones, J. B. Bygones, and William Bygones, who are
lawfully appointed Commissioners for the purpose, any other of
whom may act, do divide the Chastel Estate Consisting of
Mules, Stock of Hogs, Cattle and farming implements belong-
ing to the farm known as the "Old place" in Southampton
County, into two parts of equal value, as nearly as possible,
the Guardian of the Infant defendant, Margaret A. Bygones
and make report to Court.
