This Cause came on this day by consent of parties to be heard on the joint and several answers of the defendants Richard S. Bryant administrator of Thomas Everett dec'd Martha F. Everett Abner Carter and Sally Ann Carter, and James T. Hill and Elizabeth Hill, the owners of the three infant defendants, Joseph Williams, Thomas Williams and Jimmy Williams by L. R. Edwards their guardian ad litem appeared for that purpose with general application thereto, by the Plaintiffs, examination of witnesses, exhibits filed and was argued by counsel on the consideration whereof the Court doth adjudged, order and decree, that Richard S. Bryant also is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose upon receiving the purchase money, he will the sum of Two hundred & twenty five dollars with interest thereon from the 12th day of November 1857, & the costs of this suit, at any time within sixty days from the date of this decree, from the defendants or any of them, or any person for them, convey to the defendants, Children of the said Thomas Everett deceased, the tract of land in the bill mentioned, and upon failure so to appear to pay the sum of money and costs then the said Commissioner is directed, after having given at least two public sales in the neighborhood, proceed to sell on the premises at public auction to the highest bidder the tract of land now held by Thomas Everett's heirs, containing by estimation eighty acres & being the tract of land sold by James Mayhew to Thomas Everett, on the following terms to wit: Sufficient cash to pay expenses of sale and costs of this suit, the balance of the purchase money on a credit of twelve months dating from the purchase or a bond with approved security and retaining the title until all the purchase money shall have been paid and return the same with his report to this Court in order to a further decree, but the said Commissioner shall not proceed to act until this decree is entered and he or some one for him shall have presented in the Clerk's office of this Court a bond in the penalty of Five hundred dollars with good and sufficient security for a faithful performance of this and any subsequent decrees which may be entered in this cause.
