This day this cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read, and on the report of Commissioners Nathan Wood presented to a docketed order entered in this cause at the November Term of this Court 1857, and was argued by counsel, on consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree, that that part of the Commissioners report March 27th showing what amount is to be paid by each of the Legatees to Henry Edward Bailey, the fatherless child be confirmed, and that the said Mary B. Bailey pay to the legally qualified guardian of Henry Edward Bailey, the Sum of Seventy three dollars and eight, seven Cents, and that James Henry Bailey pay the Sum of Eighty five dollars and sixty four Cents to the said, and that Erastus A. Bailey pay to the said the Sum of thirty six dollars and fifty cents, and that William Bailey pay to the said the Sum of twenty five dollars and seventy seven Cents, it being the respective amounts specified against each of them in account of Commissioners report. That the Court doth further, adjudge, order and decree, that one of the Commissioners of this Court, settle the account March 27th in account returned by Commissioner Nathan, and in so doing he is directed to consider more in said account, in including two bills valued at fifty dollars, and eight chains valued at four dollars, amongst the articles not belonging to the said to keep up the farm. And the said Commissioner is also directed to settle a further account of Mary B. Bailey's transactions as administratrix of Henry S. Bailey decd. which said account, he is directed to examine, settle, and make return thereof to this Court, next any matter especially stated by him except, or which may be required to be so stated by any of the parties.
