It being suggested to the Court that Mary I. Ridley, has intermarried with Nat. I. Ridley. Since the last hearing of this cause, it is shown that she has procured in the name of said Nat. I. Ridley & wife, and this day this cause came on to be heard on the papers formerly read, and on the report of Commissioner Howard, made under a warrant of this Court issued at November Term 1866, on Subpoena (A. P. W.) and (P. W.) filed in this cause and was argued by counsel, the consideration whereof the Court adopting said Subpoena made (A. P. W.) and (P. W.) as the basis of its decree, doth adjudge, Order and decree, that Thomas Ridley Guardian for the children of Robert Ridley doth pay and deliver to Robert Ridley the Plaintiff, Twenty five hundred dollars of the bonds of the City of Petersburg, the same amount of said bonds to Nat. I. Ridley wife and retain the same amount of said bonds for each of his wards Joseph B. and Sallie A. Ridley. The Court doth further adjudge, Order and decree, that the said Thomas Ridley, pay over and deliver to the Plaintiff, Robert Ridley, Twenty five hundred dollars in nominal value of the 4 per cent Confederate bonds in his hands, the same amount of said bonds to Nat. I. Ridley wife, and retain a like amount for each of his wards Joseph B. & Sallie A. Ridley. And the Court doth adjudge, Order and decree, that Thomas Ridley pay to the Plaintiff Robert Ridley, the sum of Eight hundred and Sixteen dollars and twenty cents, with interest thereon from December 21st 1865, till paid, to pay to Nat. I. Ridley & Mary his wife, a like sum, with like interest, and retain a like sum, for each of his wards, Joseph B. and Sallie A. Ridley. And the Court doth further adjudge, Order and
