still failing to appear and Master defined, came on to be heard on the Bill

Order and decree, that a Commissioner of the Court take the following
accounts: 1st An account of the transactions of John B. Jenkins as
administrator of Jeremiah Norfolk doth. 2^d An account of the
debt due by the said Jeremiah Norfolk, or his Estate and their
debtors. 3^d An account of the real Estate of which said Jeremiah
Norfolk doth seized, (subject to the dower thereof of his Widow,) and
the fit sample and annual value thereof. And Master report with any
Matters specially stated, deemed pertinent by him or which any
of the parties may require to be so stated.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning eleven o'clock.
