This day the Court came on to be again heard upon the papers formerly read and the report of Commissioner Howard made in pursuance of the decree pronounced by the November Term 1857, to which report there are no exceptions and was argued by Counsel, Asstt. Comr. & others whereof the Court doth Conform to the said report, and doth adjudge, order and direct, that the said Defendants James L. Bowdoin, Esq. and others to John Bowdoin Jr. who is hereby appointed as a Receiver for that purpose, the sum amounting to One Thousand and Sixty five Dollars & Sixty eight Cents, encumbered in the Special Statement of Commissioner Howard as having been received by the said Mary L. Bowdoin late Guardian of Williams and Pittaway Johnson from Dr. Asaph T. Gay attorney of Jeptha H. Johnson et al taken in behalf of others which shall be so reduced to less, the sum of Jeptha Hedges and S. Daniels Wilson to David H. Johnson amounting with the interest to the 31st of December 1857, to the sum of One hundred & Twenty two Dollars & fifty five cents with the sum of One hundred and Sixty five Dollars & Sixty three Cents to the sum of William H. Stephens and James H. Bowdoin to Mary L. Johnson Guardian for William D. Pittaway Johnson amounting with interest to the 31st of December 1857, to One hundred and fifty Seven Dollars & Eighty two Cents, the sum of James Johnson and Lewis Johnson to the sum amounting with interest to the 31st of December 1857, to Eighty Seven Dollars & Twenty Nine Cents, and the sum of Dr. W. H. Stephens & John P. Boykin to the sum amounting with interest to the 31st of December 1857, to the sum of Sixty two Dollars & eighty two Cents. That the said Receiver proceed to collect the said sum as rapidly as possible and pay one half of the amount collected to the Plaintiff and the other half thereof subject to the future trial of the cause. — And the Court doth further adjudge, order & direct, that the said Defendants James L. Bowdoin be and they are all directed to pay the said defendant the balance of the indebtedness to the said Plaintiff as ascertained by the said Commissioner's report, with the costs necessary to remove from the said Johnson Island, and the said M. S. Watson Administrator of Wm. H. Johnson in the payment of these bonds. And the said Receiver is required to report his proceedings herein to the County.
