 pay to said Samuel B. Wells, the sum of Forty two Dollars & fifty Six Cents, the
 amount due by them as per said Statement (X), With interest from this day,
 and that Richard S. Boffin pay to said Samuel B. Wells the sum of One Thousand
 Three hundred & Fifty four Dollars & Fifty four Cents, amount due and so appears
 by said Statement (X) With interest from this day, and that this last sum
 amount to paid out of the assets due to the said Richard S. Boffin as
 administrator of said John Smith & Co. And whereas it appears by said Comprehensive
 Report that out of the assets due to the Estate of John Smith & Co. and not in
 Debt & held by the Executor of Wm. H. Sumnerwell, who was one of the
 Executors of John Smith & Co. there is due as follows, To Kenneth M.
 Boffin, (as Curator) Five thousand & Eighty eight Dollars & Sixty Nine Cents,
 and to John C. Griffin & Hannis his wife, Eighteen hundred & Ninety three
 Dollars, & Fifty three Cents, and to Kenneth M. Wagoner & Mary D. his
 wife, Four thousand & Eighty four Dollars & Sixty Seven Cents, and to
 Richard S. Boffin the sum of Three thousand Three hundred & forty two
 Dollars & twenty Six Cents, all Making the sum of Eleven thousand
 Two hundred & Nine Dollars & twenty Six Cents, The Court doth order,
 after due view, that the said Samuel B. Wells & J. S. Boffin, Executors of
 Wm. H. Sumnerwell's debt, who was one of the Administrators of John Smith & Co. did
 pay over to John C. Griffin, and Wm. H. Boffin, who are appointed Receivers
 for this purpose, such of the Bonds now in their hands as such Executors and as
 reported by Comprehensive Report in amount as will be equal to the said
 Eleven thousand Two hundred & Nine Dollars & twenty Six Cents, in full
 payment of the same, and that out of the sum of Three thousand Three
 hundred & Forty two Dollars & twenty Six Cents due Richard S. Boffin,
 there be paid to Samuel B. Wells as above in said Bonds the sum of
 Thousand Three hundred & fifty four Dollars & Fifty four Cents, in discharge
 of the amount due him by said Richard S. Boffin. And the
 Court doth further adjudge, order, and decree that the said John
 C. Griffin, & Wm. H. Boffin Receivers as aforesaid proceed to
 collect the Bonds thus directed to be paid over to them as aforesaid
 and as far as collected pay the same payable to the said Kenneth
 M. Wagoner, Curator of said John Smith & Co. and to John C. Griffin
 and Hannis his wife, & to Kenneth M. Wagoner & Mary D. his wife, and to
 Richard S. Boffin, according to the respective
 amounts to which they are entitled as above and that the amount
 of the several payments to be made under this Court be returned
 and filed in this cause, And the Court doth further adjudge, order
 and decree, that Samuel B. Wells, surviving Executor of said
 Richard S. Boffin, and Samuel B. Postlewaite & J. S. Boffin, Executors
 of Wm. H. Sumnerwell, and who was the other Executor of said
