This Cause came on this day to be again heard on the papers formerly read and on the Report of Commissioner N. S. Howard, made pursuant to the Order of November Term 1867, and on examination of witnesses, and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof (there being no exception to the said Report) the Court doth adjudge Order and Decree that the Plaintiff recover of the Defendant John C. Griffin the Sum of \$650.00 (Six Hundred and Fifty Dollars and twenty two Cents.) With Interest at Five hundred and Eleven Dollars and Seventy Seven Cents, past thereof from the Sixth July 1861, till paid, and the Costs of this Suit.
