This cause this day came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read together
with the report of Commissioner Howard, made in pursuance of a Term, decided
in this cause, at the last term of this Court, to which report there being no
exception, the same is hereby confirmed. On consideration whereof, upon the
arguments of Counsel, The Court doth adjudge Order and decree, that the
said Samuel H. Eaton's Chancery report and attached copy of this Record, upon
the "First Savings Distribution," in the City of Norfolk, Virginia, for the
sum of One Thousand & Ninety Nine Dollars & Thirty four Cents. (\$399.35cts.)
portion of the Five Hundred and Fourteen Dollars, and Twenty four Cents,
deposited there, on the 29th May A.D. 1856. With the interest amount
of the said One Thousand and Ninety Nine Dollars and thirty four Cents
from the said 29th May 1856, and for the further sum of Three hundred
and twenty Dollars & fifty four Cents. (\$320.54cts.) portion of the Four-hundred
and forty three Dollars and Sixty eight Cents, deposited in the said Savings Bank
on the 22nd April, 1857. With interest on the said sum of Three
hundred & twenty Dollars & fifty four Cents, from the said 22nd April
1857, full paid. The said sum of Three hundred and Ninety Nine Dollars
and Thirty four Cents, being One hundred and forty three Dollars and fifty four Cents,
to be recorded and held by the said Samuel H. Eaton, as his own
right, in fee and in lieu of his life Estate, in the effect of the said
respective sum of Four hundred and Fourteen Dollars, & Thirty four
Cents, and Four hundred and forty three Dollars and Sixty eight Cents,
