This cause came on to be again heard on the papers formerly read & on the Report of  
 Lewis Thomas aged guardian, to the Honors of May 26<sup>th</sup> 1868 & returned June 15<sup>th</sup>  
 to which report there is no exception, & as the petition of Charles Knapp, Elizabeth de la Serna  
 & R. Briggs & Co. & was refused by Court. Do however being always the bank and  
 assigns the said Report & with assigns, and as under the J. S. Spiller to the assignee, pat-  
 rons of dect, that she take charge of all the estate of said firm & proceed without delay  
 to collect the same & pay it down to the debt and pay said firm as respects its dect  
 Account Report & make report to Court. And the Court doth further assign, order & decree,  
 that W. B. Shurt, who is hereby appointed Receiver for the purpose, take charge of the  
 debt and be the firm of Spiller & Smith & collect the same as far as practicable, &  
 report to Court, and the Court doth further assign, order & decree, that Any E. Thomas senior  
 of Spiller & Smith dect, pay out of the money in his hands as bank about the date of the  
 said unduly, & for 1869, dollars to each of the following assignees, to wit, E. W.  
 Manufacturing, John S. Spiller, W. B. Shurt, John J. Thomas & W. H. Spiller, and this  
 before the balance in the English bank belonging to the said J. S. Thomas & Eighty and  
 balance & twenty eight cents, with interest on five thousand & twenty two dollars & thirty eight  
 cents, paid out from the 2<sup>d</sup> May 1867, to the credit of the bank to be allowed and  
 by terms of this order, & make report to Court filing the certificate of bank deposits  
 which said assigns to be and by him to said bank as far as amount "82" of said  
 Court Report reports made of under the Court of December Term 1867,  
 and the Court doth further assign, order & decree that Any E. Thomas, who is hereby  
 appointed Receiver for the purpose, proceed to see the bank through the said J.  
 E. Spiller dect assign & assigns, (subject however to the Court's order of said J.  
 Spiller, dect & said dect), described as a tract of land in the County of Rock  
 containing six hundred & eighty seven acres, more or less, & adjoining the lands of  
 before the trustees dect of said bank, or some part say, it and also on a tract of  
 & under assigns, (except for the purpose of deed which may be made, & which may be  
 paid into, taking said said good coming from the parcel now & remain the same as  
 the parties were of the Court, having first given it due notice of said land  
 & assignments, to the trustees dect of said bank, & it remains the parties
