This Cause came on to be heard on this day, on the papers formerly read, and it
 being suggested to the Court, & shown by Joseph Wardwell & Parsons, Messrs. H. Tamm
 reports filed in the Cause heretofore that a portion of the creditors of Edgely
 Rogers' had received of him a discharge of his debt only, of the appt. in his
 hands, while others remained his creditors and nothing further having been said
 by said Tamm, he shd. be directed to pay to these creditors the amt. owing
 of him as ordered by decree of May Court 1847, and it being suggested
 to the Court that John B. Whitehead who owes to said Tamm the
 amount which was to have been paid distributed by a Bankrupt, and
 nothing to be had from him - Therefore it is ordered and decreed that
 some other like discharge be made up of all payments made by
 him under the said decree of May Court 1847, and that any money
 due by him & not distributed, together with the amount due by
 John W. Bennett as referred to in the decree of May Court 1847;
