Compton who was jointly procurer with James S. Windham of the Clerk's appointment lost under date of May 1st 1861, has relinquished his right therin to said James S. Windham, It is ordered that the Sheriff be ordered to said James S. Windham for the same - And it appearing to the Court by attorney G. F. Johnson this day, that the sum of Eleven hundred & forty three dollars & forty four cents remains due by E. C. Bennett, R. H. Stephens, John E. Kilby, & Bay, D. Kindred, which interest to the amount of Three dollars & fifty six cents from the 1st above 1861, It is ordered that the said last named parties pay to said James Hargrove, & Concomitantly the sum of Eleven hundred & forty three dollars & twenty five cents, with interest to the amount of Two thousand one hundred & Eleven dollars & fifty six cents, forty four cents from the 1st November 1861, to be accounted for by him under this Second, and such exceeding sum for the same, and that said James Hargrove, makes report to County - And it is further ordered that William H. Daugherty, makes report of any collections he may have regard to the same his last report.
