Mapenburg is dead & that his Estate has been committed to the hands of Somersville late Sheriff of Southwicks County for administration with that Patrick Kelly is dead and that Dr. McSorley has qualifications as his administrator up to the will annexe, and that John S. Williams is dead & Edward Rantle is his widow, and that James A. Bots has been declared in Bankruptcy and that Washington L. Botskert is his assignee. It is by Consents of parties, except that here after this cause shall be prosecuted in the Name of the said Alexander W. Atchells against Somersville Sheriff & Commissioner of Probate, deceased. W. L. Rockwell Assignee in Bankruptcy of J. A. Bots, James Holmes, Allen Edwards, John Bots, Edward Bots alias of John A. W. Murray, Dr. McSorley administrator of Patrick Kelly deceased & Warren Edwards, and the same coming on to be heard according to papers formerly read and to arguments of Counsel, the Court doth adjudge, and it is directed, that the Commissioner of this County ascertain whether E. W. Mapenburg has paid into the hands of the Sheriff One Thousand One hundred & Eighty Seven Dollars & Seventy Five Cents and the sum of Two Thousand two hundred & Thirty Eight Dollars & fifty Seven Cents, as directed by the decree of May twenty fifth, and whether the said defendant has accounted for all the property of the real estate by him as Trustee from the date from which Monroe & reported to in the cause, & if so, whether there is any due to him by any of the purchasers of said Estate, any part of the purchase money & how much, & whether said sum have been paid to the purchasers of the real Estate sold by said E. W. Mapenburg and whether any rights to land.
