

The decree of May Term 1869, to which report there is no exception
and in the report of B. C. Worrell declining to act as Commissioner
under said decree, and in the report of W. B. Briggs declining to
act as Receiver under said decree, and was argued by Counsel;
On Consideration whereof, the Court doth direct that Benjamin
E. Worrell, the Sheriff of this County, proceed to make the return
of the Land of Joseph E. Gilllette dec'd. as directed by decree
of May Term last, and also that said Sheriff take charge
of the debts and accounts due the late firm of Gilllette &
Freiborn, & collect the same, or ascertaining their value on
Worrell's report to Court and it is ordered that a Commissioner
of this Court, make up a statement of all debts due
by Joseph E. Gilllette and a separate statement of
all debts due by Gilllette & Freiborn, taking the
reports of Commissioner Howard as correct, and
in addition thereto the claims of J. H. Ranssard & Co.
the day filed by said Freiborn, and any other claims not
heretofore reported, and make report to Court.
And it is further ordered that a Commissioner of
this Court make up a further account of the
transactions of said Benjamin E. Worrell as
administrator of Joseph E. Gilllette dec'd.
And it is further ordered that the said Benjamin
E. Worrell be summoned to the next Term of
this Court to show cause why and attachments
should not issue against him for failing to
deposit in the Sheriff's Treasury the amounts in
his hands as administrator of Joseph E. Gilllette
as directed by the decree of May Term 1869.
