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This Court came on this day, to be again heard, on the papers formerly read out on the Report of Commissioner Tyler. These papers were to the Town of Concord June 1817, of this County to which, after there is no exception, and was signed by Committee, on Concord and when of the Court do not confirm the said Report and do not assign. Order and decree, that if Joshua Peckham, the original plaintiff, shall within four months from this day pay to John E. Kelly (who is hereby appointed a Commissioner for the purpose of receiving the same,) the sum of Twelve hundred and forty five dollars and seventy five cents, with interest at Twelve hundred and four dollars and eighty cents per annum from the day, till, then the said John E. Kelly can or otherwise, and, as he is hereby directed to do, coming by and with special authority, in the name of the Court, to give the said Joshua Peckham, the two parts of one Estate of land in Concord, New Hampshire, described as follows, (to wit) A Lot in the Village of Franklin, in said County, situate in the West or west morning from York to South, & the said Brook, containing two fourths of an acre, more or less; and another York of the Land of the said Kelly and Jos.
