and the Report of Commissioner White containing a further report of James
& Williams Administrators of Mills & Gray, died, and an addi-
tional report of the said Commissioner against the said Mills & Gray's estate
and the Report of Susannah L. Selby, Sheriff, who was appointed Commissioner
to take the Land whereof John L. Gray, died, seized & possessed, who had
made sales of the same & to all of which Reports the exceptions have been
filed & was argued by Counsel. The Commissioner shews of the Court
conforming the said Reports with evidence taken & sworn that Commissioner
Gray withdrew the sum of Ten thousand four hundred & seventy five dollars which
he had filed in the papers of this Cause & collect the same & after
paying any additional costs which may have accrued, pay into the
Court as follows, 1st To Benjamin & Fife, Eight hundred & four cents
& Judgment decreed by him in the Land, to Benjamin & Fife, fifty five
dollars & thirty cents & Judgment decreed by him in the Land, to H.
P. Fife, thirty three dollars & ten cents & Judgment decreed by him in the
