Bills 2 In Chancery

This Cause came on this day to be heard on the papers formerly sent and made before of Court before Bills & Committee of J. G. Batt et al - Judge presiding at the time of the 1st June 1859, to which before there is no objection, and made petition of Wm. H. Bill et al on this day filed and was argued by Counsel, & consideration had of the said Court before whom the said Appellants and others appearing, were called the Plaintiff's Collector etc. Consideration had in the Court of Representatives of both J. G. Batt et al and of the Plaintiff et al of the former party, any costs remaining unpaid and then paid to Bank of N.Y.C. College Fund part only of the debt due at this day filed in said petition, to make the Plaintiff agree with the former party until made under the Report afterwards, and any balance unpaid in the Plaintiff's Bank by themselves and to make right the corders of such payment and deposit.

Bills 3 In Chancery

This cause came on this day to be heard on the bill of the complainants taken before and as the defendant Samuel Kelle, Wm. Butler, or their successors had been duly received & they still failing to appear and make defense and on the award of R. M. Dyer this day filed and communicated of witness and replication to said award and on the Report of Commissioners before, made pursuant to the Order made in this Court at Newbern Jan 1858 to which Report there is no exception it was argued by Counsel, & consideration had of the same in deciding upon question in this cause, whereupon it is ordered and

decreed, That Wm. H. Briggs Sheriff of Southampton County present to the Plaintiff before the Court before due of said County, at least one day the last before to be in the proceeding to describe in the Bill of Costs executed by Pursuivans before to Wm. H. Butler a copy of the Bill of Costs as dated the 1st day of March 1858, and to send the same to the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas of the County of Southampton affixing Black Seal, a copy of which Bill is filed in this cause. That the said Bill be held on credit of the Plaintiff on those grounds with interest from date (except that he have sufficient to pay the cost of his suit and expenses of said Bill to be paid to those who bring him) bringing from the purchaser Rent and good possession security and also the title bill and further title of Plaintiff, having first given a bond timely day return for such sale by advertisement at the Court house door of said County and Plaintiff and Tenant at the said public place in said County, and makes report to Court Clerk by said Sheriff so made Plaintiff and Tenant shall the said Court Sheriff bring to court those grounds of the Plaintiff which afford it is applied for taxation.
