It being suggested to the Court that under the Certificate of Stock of the State of Virginia filed in the papers of this Cause be found, under the act of the General Assembly of Va. approved March 20<sup>th</sup> 1811, or on before January 1<sup>st</sup> 1812, the parties were disposed of living there, at the Court being of opinion that the interest of the owner of said Certificate was protected by having the same to be found according to the provisions of said act of the General Assembly, don't agree to draw and issue that proclamatory warrant which is appointed a form for that purpose, withdraw from the papers of the Cause the following Certificate of State Stock, to wit, Certificate No 277 dated Jan 27<sup>th</sup> 1811, for \$800, and Certificate No 779 dated Feb 12<sup>th</sup> 1850, each in the name of Mary A. Boggs also Certificate No 724 dated 21<sup>st</sup> Apr 1849, and Certificate No 238 dated Jan 27<sup>th</sup> 1848, each for the sum of \$800. Each in the name of Elizabeth Carter Boggs. And the said Court is directed to find the said Certificates under the provisions of the act aforesaid, in either Company or registered bond, and return the said Bond to Court to await its further Order. But the said Court shall not at under this decree cause the same enter into Bond and Surety in the Clerk's Office of this Court before the Clerk in the sum of \$3200. Conditioned according to law.

They came this day Cause no. to be again heard on the papers forming

beginning of May Term 1871, and was argued by Counsel; on Consideration whereof, the Court Confirming said Report to which  
no exception was filed, doth adjudge, Order as follows, That  
until the Defendant M. D. Butler within sixty days from the  
date of this decree, pay the several Judgment Creditors named  
in said Report, the amounts shown thereby to be respectively due them,  
that C. B. Hayden who is hereby appointed special Commissioner  
for that purpose, shall proceed to sue at public action  
at the Court House of this County on some Court day,  
after having given at least twenty days notice of the  
time and place of suit by advertisement at the Court  
house door up this County, on some Court day previous  
to the day of sale, and at other public places in this  
County, on a credit of one, two and three years in equal payments,  
with interest from the day of sale except so much for Cash
