It being suggested to the said that such the Certificate of stock of the State of Virginia filed in the papers of this Cause to fund, would the act of the said Assembly of Va. approve March 20th 1841 or before Jan'y 1st 1850. The parties are in dispute of issuing them, and the Court being of opinion that the interest of the owner of said Certificate are best protected by coming the same to be funded according to the provisions of said act of the General Assembly, doth adjudge Order and decree that Jacob A. Hensley who is appointed a Commissioner for that purpose, withdraw from the papers of this Cause the following Certificate of State Stock, to wit, Certificate No. 277 dated Jan'y 27th 1848, for \$800, and Certificate No. 779 dated Feb'y 12th 1850, each in the name of Mary A. Organ. Also Certificate No. 724 dated 21st Apr'l 1849, and Certificate No. 278 dated Jan'y 27th 1848, each for the sum of \$800. Each in the name of Elizabeth Gordon Organ. And the said Court is directed to fund the said Certificates under the provisions of the act aforesaid, in either Bonds or registered bonds, and return the said Bonds to Court to await its future Order. But the said Court shall not act under this decree until he either enter into Bond and Security in the Clerk's Office for this Court before the Clerk in the sum of \$3200. Conditioned according to Law.
