This day the Court came and to be heard at the proper former seat, and at the request of Commissioner Taylor, of the Administration of James H. Williams and Edward Williams, Executors, and as the Request of James Williams of the date of the real estate in the said judgment, and as a result of Counsel, the Commission thereof, the Court shall order and decree, that the said Request be refused in everything except the sum of the Confirmed, and the Court doth further adjudge, and decree, that James H. Williams, who is appointed as Commissioner for the purpose of withdrawing from the property in this Cause the two Bonds of John H. Robbins, Executor for the purchase of James Fort's parcel of land, and for the sum of Four hundred and seven dollars and fifty cents on 18th January 1871, and also to do and to do as therein required, shall not have when due to apply the proceeds towards the payment of the said Bonds filed in this Cause executed by Susan Williams to Edward Williams and Request to Court. And this Court shall be suspended until James H. Williams, shall make such Bond and Security as the Court of 1872 in the said Cause of this Court, (conditions according to law.)

This day the Court came and to be further heard at the proper former seat, the Request of Commissioner Taylor filed during the term, and as a result of Counsel, as Commission thereof, the Court shall adjudge the said Request as the basis of this Cause, the Commission having been filed, and the said Request, both adjudge, order and decree, that unless the Bond of J. H. G. B. Robbins, filed in this Cause and paid in or before the 1st day of November 1872 in full, then, that the same Commissioner who sold under the order of 1871 on 18th January 1872, be and he is hereby authorized to receive the real estate for which the said Bonds of and executed, upon the following terms, to wit: enough in Cash to defray expenses of said ad sales, the balance proceeds in any two and other years, the purchase to become Bond of the said property, carrying interest from day of sale, and the title to be returned for the deferred payments - And the Court doth further order, that the Sheriff of this County, serve a Copy of this order, to the said J. H. G. B. Robbins, and the said Commissioner shall be directed to make return to Court of his proceedings under this order.
